Venue Access: Access to the venue and paddock areas will be from 18:00 Thursday 21st July. All personnel must be in possession of a pass to gain access to the venue.

Paddock: Please park neatly in the space allocated to your championship / series without wasting space. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused.

Signing On for Competitors: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Scrutineering: All cars must be presented for Scrutineering prior to taking to the circuit. Scrutineering will take place at the Scrutineering Bay between 15:00 and 18:00 on Friday 22nd July and from 07:15 on Saturday 23rd July.

Drivers Briefings: All drivers must read the Drivers' briefing notes in advance of the event. Additionally face-to-face briefings are scheduled as follows;

Pirelli Ferrari *formula classic* Series = 09:00 Saturday in the FOC members hospitality marquee

Alfa Romeo Championship = 09:30 Saturday in the Alfa Romeo Paddock area

DDMC Northern Saloon & Sports Car Championship = 10:00 Saturday in the DDMC NSSCC Paddock area

Ferrari Hot Lap Challenge = 09:00 Sunday in the FOC members hospitality marquee

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable.

Circuit Access: Access to the Circuit will be as follows;

PFfc – will join the circuit directly from the Pitlane for Practice & Qualifying, but must go to the Assembly Area for the races.

DDMC NSSCC, Alfa Romeo & Ferrari Hot Lap Challenge – will join the circuit via the Assembly Area.

All cars may be noise tested in compliance with Motorsport UK General Regulation J.5.17-18 prior to being released onto the circuit. Drivers should be ready 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed onto the circuit.

Final Instructions

Stop/Go & Drive Through Penalties: The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to impose a 'Stop/Go Penalty / Drive Through penalty' in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation [Q 12.26].

End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each track session, all vehicles must slow down and enter the Pitlane following the marshals instructions to return to the Paddock / Parc-Fermé area as required.

Race Starts / Grids: Prior to each race, cars will be released from the Assembly Area to form up on the grid in the positions specified on the published grid sheet. The countdown will then commence at the 1 minute signal followed by a formation lap before a standing start in accordance with the relevant Championship / Series regulations.

Official Notice Board / Information: The organisers will try to run the programme as published, but they reserve the right to delay or bring forward event times to suit the conditions of the day. Copies of practice times & results will be published online at www.tsl-timing.com

The Official Notice Board for the event is located at Race Control.

Entry List: Please check your entry on the published entry list and notify us immediately if it is incorrect, this will ensure an accurate programme.

Protests / Appeals:

Protests and Appeals should be lodged in accordance with Motorsport UK General Regulations. Should you be called to Race Control to see the Clerk of the Course or The Stewards, please respect physical distancing. Penalties will be announced verbally and published on the Official Notice Board.

Marshals Instructions: All marshals and officials must 'sign on' before commencing their duties. There will be a marshals briefing at 08:30 each day outside of the Paddock Café.
